



We're Standing up for Students and **Taking Action to Fund our Schools!**

Oregon schools are in crisis after decades of disinvestment. Our schools have one of the largest average class sizes in the nation -- which means students are missing out on the individual attention they need to be successful.

Lawmakers are currently considering a proposal called the Student Success Act which would invest \$2 billion into Oregon schools - an 18% increase in K-12 funding. This would make a huge difference for our students and be a great step toward fully funding our schools.

This is our moment - lawmakers are seriously considering this investment in our future, the political stage is set, and pressure from educators, parents, advocates, and supporters is mounting.

Educators around the state are taking action on May 8th to put pressure on lawmakers to fund our schools. It's a disruption - and a long-term investment in our future.
